SSAG, Terms of Reference (defined December 2014)

Developed in collaboration with ECOM, care taken to avoid overlap with ATC

To provide a link between fundamental research and the use of that research to meet the needs of ISTA members.
....in collaboration with any appropriate ISTA TCOMs, would identify appropriate ISTA laboratories to encourage their collaboration with the seed scientists and help develop the plans for a work programme, including the selection of appropriate seed material'. (E. g. Prediction of normal germination using radicle emergence)
To appraise evidence for techniques/equipment available for use in seed testing laboratories.
To respond to requests from ECOM and TCOM Chairs for advice related to scientific issues.





SSAG

ATC
